Late 19th and early 20th century was a period when a lot of efforts were put forth by philanthropists and princely states to educate the youth of India. Large number of schools, colleges and Universities were established during the period throughout the country. Two great institutions, namely Uday Pratap College (formerly known as Hewett Kshatriya College) and Kashi Hindu Vishwavidyalaya were established in the north and South parts of Varanasi during this period. While the latter was established by Mahatma Madan Mohan Malviya for which funds were arranged through donations, the former was established by Maharaja Uday Pratap Singh Jodhpuri for which funds were arranged by Maharaja through his personal resources. Maharaja Uday Pratap Singh Jodhpuri was a visionary leader, philanthropist, and a stalwart of educational and social reform in India. As the founder of Uday Pratap College, Varanasi, his contributions to the field of education remain a beacon of inspiration for generations. This seminar seeks to explore his legacy, his vision for a progressive society, and his lasting impact on education and social development.
