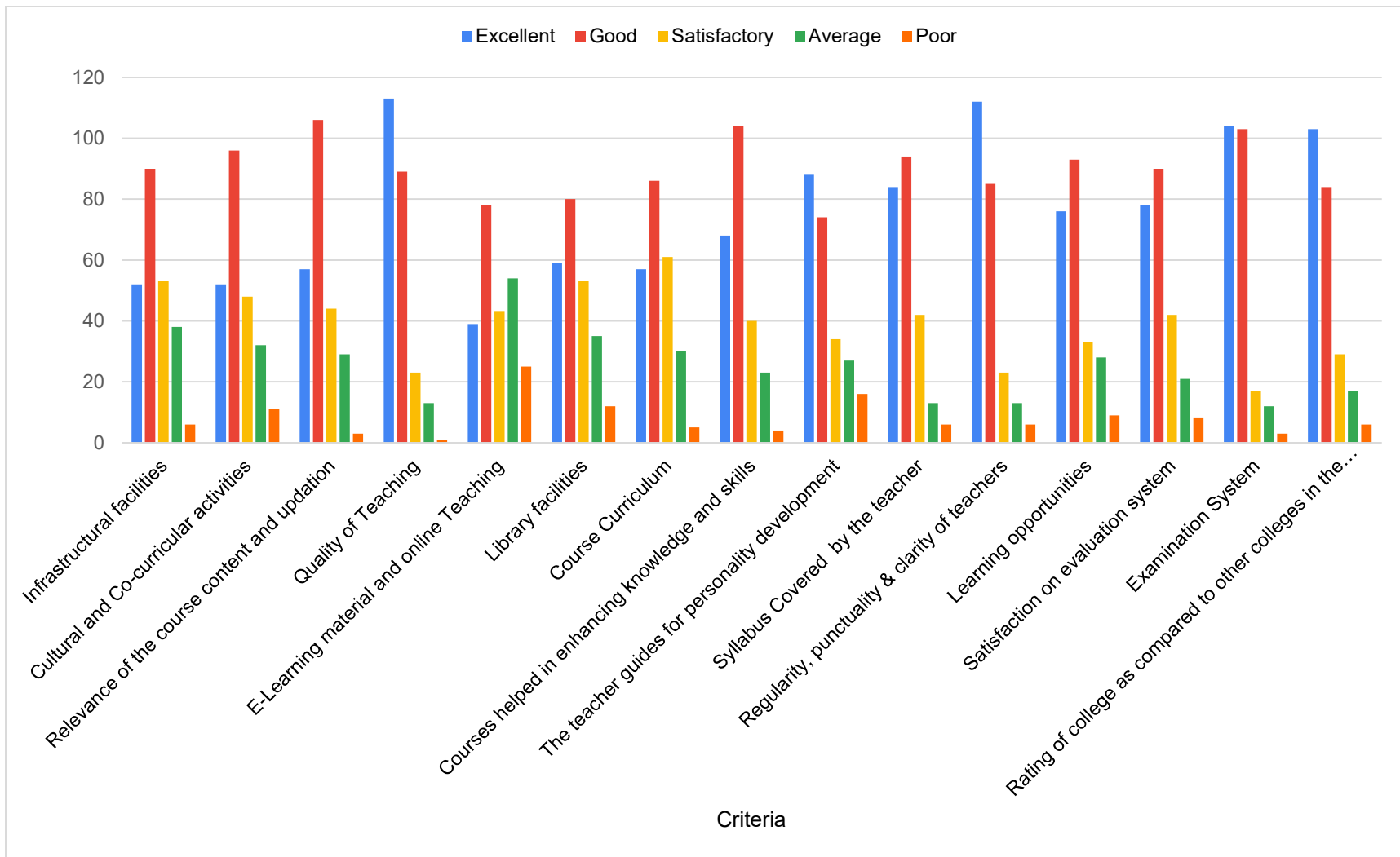
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Students' Feedback Analysis Report – 2019-2020

The data collected through an online Google form embedded in college's website from students has been categorized into 15 criteria/statements. The responses have been analyzed on a scale ranging from "Excellent" to "Poor." The following report summarizes the findings, highlights strengths, and identifies areas for improvement.

Overall, 239 students responded to the feedback regarding various aspects of Udai Pratap College. The criteria with the highest ratings include quality of teaching, teacher guides for personality development, and examination system. The criteria with the lowest ratings include e-learning material and online teaching, library facilities, and satisfaction on the evaluation system. The key observations and suggestions for improvement based on the feedback provided are summarized here.

Key Observations:

- 1) The majority of students rated the quality of teaching as excellent, indicating a high level of satisfaction in this aspect.
- 2) E-learning resources and online teaching received mixed feedback, suggesting the need for further improvement in these areas.
- 3) The college excels in infrastructure, with a significant number of students rating it as good or excellent.
- 4) Opportunities for learning and growth, as well as the contribution to personality development by teachers, received positive feedback.
- 5) The examination system and course curriculum were generally well-received by students.


Recommendations:

- 1) Enhance e-learning resources and the availability of online teaching to meet the evolving needs of students.
- 2) Address areas where satisfaction is lower, such as online teaching, library facilities, and syllabus coverage.
- 3) Continue the positive practices in teaching quality, infrastructure, and overall student development.

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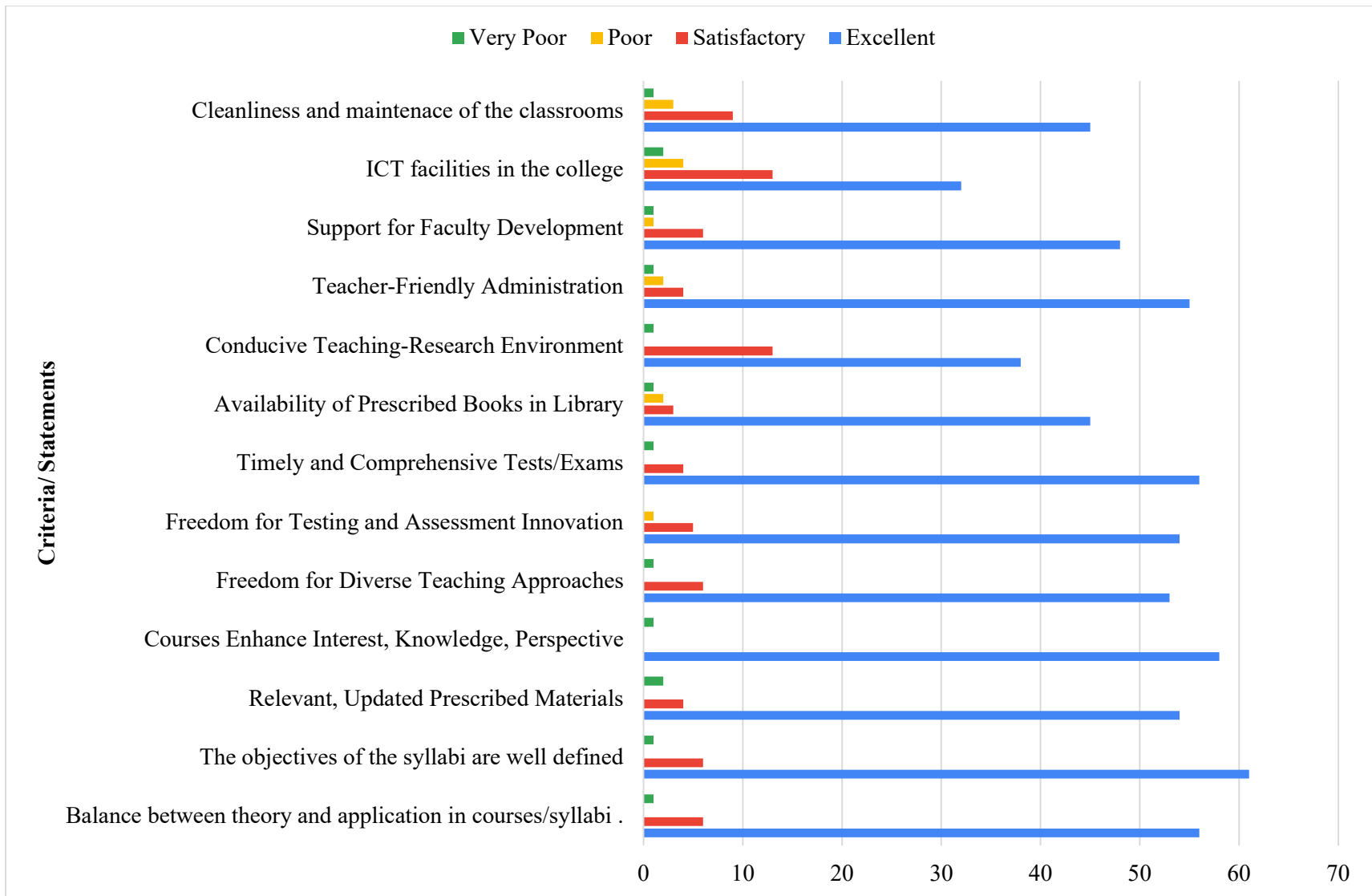

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Teachers' Feedback Analysis Report – 2019-2020

In this Teachers' Feedback Analysis Report for the academic session 2019-20, we delve into the valuable feedback provided by the teaching faculty at Udai Pratap College, Varanasi. The data collected through an online Google form embedded in college's website from faculty members has been categorized into 13 criteria/statements. The responses have been analyzed on a scale ranging from "Excellent" to "Very Poor." Collected across various critical criteria, the feedback from 79 respondents offers a detailed insight into the strengths and areas for improvement within the academic environment. As we navigate through the data, we uncover patterns and sentiments that shed light on the satisfaction levels of teachers regarding the courses, syllabi, administrative support, and overall infrastructure. This report aims to distill these findings, providing a roadmap for the college to amplify its strengths and address specific areas that may benefit from focused enhancement efforts. Through this analysis, we endeavor to contribute to the ongoing pursuit of excellence in the educational experience offered by Udai Pratap College.

Key Findings of the teachers' feedback collected across various criteria to assess overall satisfaction and areas that may require improvement is presented here under.

- 1) **Course/Syllabi Balance:** The majority of teachers (71%) believe that the courses/syllabi have a good balance between theory and application, with 56 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 2) **Well-Defined Objectives:** A significant portion of teachers (77%) feel that the objectives of the syllabi are well defined, with 61 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 3) **Relevance of Prescribed Materials:** While the majority (68%) find the prescribed books/journals relevant, updated, and covering the entire syllabi, there is room for improvement as 6% rated it as poor or very poor.
- 4) **Interest and Knowledge Enhancement:** Most teachers (73%) indicated that the course/syllabi increased their interest, knowledge, and perspective in the subject area, with 58 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 5) **Teaching Freedom:** A majority of teachers (67%) believe that the college provides them with full freedom of teaching, with 53 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 6) **Testing and Assessment Strategies:** The majority of teachers (69%) feel that they have the freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies for testing and assessment, with 54 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 7) **Timely Conduct of Tests and Examinations:** A significant portion of teachers (71%) believe that tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus, with 56 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 8) **Availability of Prescribed Books:** Some teachers (10%) expressed concerns about the availability of prescribed books in the library. The college should consider addressing this issue to enhance resource accessibility.
- 9) **Conducive Teaching and Research Environment:** While the majority (64%) find the environment conducive to teaching and research, there is room for improvement as 14% rated it as poor or very poor.
- 10) **Teacher-Friendly Administration:** Most teachers (70%) believe that the administration is teacher-friendly, with 55 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 11) **Opportunities and Support for Faculty Development:** Most teachers (72%) feel that the college provides adequate opportunities and support for upgrading their skills and qualifications, with 48 teachers rating it as excellent.
- 12) **ICT Facilities Satisfaction:** Satisfaction with ICT facilities is relatively lower, with 41% expressing concerns. The college should consider enhancing and upgrading its ICT infrastructure.
- 13) **Classroom Cleanliness and Maintenance:** While most teachers (57%) believe that classrooms are clean and well-maintained, there is room for improvement as 13% rated it as poor or very poor.

Recommendations:

Based on the analysis, the following recommendations are suggested:

- 1) **Improve Availability of Prescribed Books:** Address concerns about the availability of prescribed books in the library by ensuring regular updates and acquisitions.
- 2) **Enhance Conducive Teaching and Research Environment:** Implement initiatives to improve the overall atmosphere, facilities, and resources to create a more conducive teaching and research environment.
- 3) **Upgrade ICT Facilities:** Consider upgrading ICT infrastructure to meet the evolving technological needs, providing modern equipment and reliable internet connectivity.
- 4) **Continuous Improvement in Classroom Maintenance:** Implement regular cleaning schedules, maintenance checks, and address reported issues promptly to create a comfortable learning environment.
- 5) **Maintain a Focus on Positive Aspects:** Acknowledge and maintain positive aspects such as teacher-friendly administration and opportunities for faculty development.

Continuous feedback and improvement efforts in these areas will contribute to an even more positive teaching and learning environment at Udai Pratap College, Varanasi. Regular assessments and open communication channels are recommended to ensure ongoing improvement.

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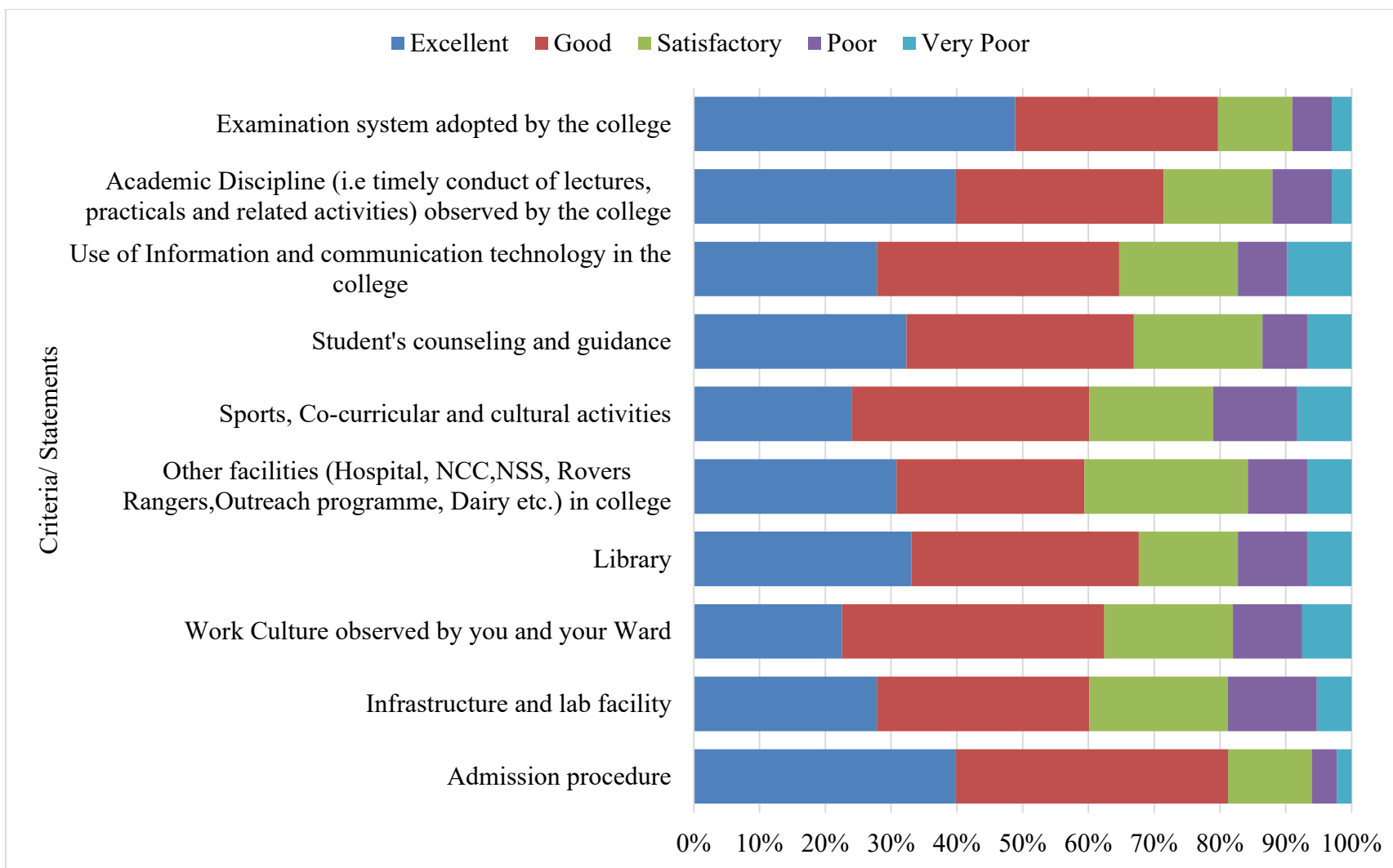
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Parents' Feedback Analysis Report – 2019-2020

Overall, 133 parents responded to the feedback regarding various aspects of Udai Pratap College. The criteria with the highest ratings include the examination system adopted by the college, admission procedure, and academic Discipline. The criteria with the lowest ratings include work culture, Sports, Co-curricular and cultural activities, and Use of Information and communication technology in college. The key observations and suggestions for improvement based on the feedback provided are summarized here.

Key Observations:

- 1) **Admission Procedure:** Most parents (53%) find the admission procedure to be excellent. A significant portion (41%) also rates it as good. Only a small percentage (5%) expressed dissatisfaction, indicating a generally positive view on the admission process.
- 2) **Infrastructure and Lab Facility:** While 37% rated the infrastructure and lab facilities as excellent, 43% considered it good. A noteworthy portion (28%) expressed a satisfactory opinion. However, there is room for improvement, with 25% giving ratings of poor or very poor.
- 3) **Work Culture:** Parents' observations of the work culture vary, with 53% finding it good. 30% rated it as excellent, but 24% expressed dissatisfaction (poor or very poor). The college may benefit from addressing concerns related to work culture.
- 4) **Library Services:** A significant number of parents (44%) rated the library services as excellent. However, 23% found it either poor or very poor, suggesting potential areas for enhancement.
- 5) **Other Facilities:** While 41% considered the additional facilities excellent, 38% rated them as good. However, 21% expressed dissatisfaction, emphasizing the need for improvement in certain aspects.
- 6) **Sports, Co-curricular, and Cultural Activities:** Parents generally appreciate the sports and co-curricular activities, with 48% giving a good rating. However, 28% expressed concerns, indicating room for improvement in these areas.
- 7) **Student Counseling and Guidance:** A substantial percentage (43%) acknowledged excellent counseling and guidance. However, 18% expressed dissatisfaction, pointing to areas that may need attention.
- 8) **Use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT):** Parents appreciate the use of ICT, with 49% rating it as good. Still, 23% expressed concerns, suggesting potential areas for technological improvement.
- 9) **Academic Discipline:** The majority (53%) of parents find academic discipline to be excellent. However, 16% expressed dissatisfaction, indicating potential areas for improvement.
- 10) **Examination System:** The examination system has received positive feedback, with 65% rating it as excellent. A smaller percentage (12%) expressed concerns, suggesting the need for continuous improvement.

Suggestions for Improvement:

- 1) Address concerns related to infrastructure and lab facilities to improve overall satisfaction.
- 2) Focus on improving the work culture to ensure a positive and motivating environment.
- 3) Address concerns related to library services to meet the diverse needs of students.
- 4) Strengthen sports and co-curricular activities to create a more vibrant and engaging campus life.
- 5) Continuously improve the use of ICT to align with modern educational standards.

These key observations and suggestions aim to provide actionable insights for Udai Pratap College, Varanasi, to enhance the overall educational experience for students and parents.
